COVID-19 Health Advisory for Coronors and Funeral Homes

Benton-Franklin Health District is closely monitoring an outbreak of respiratory illness caused by a novel (new) coronavirus (named SARS-CoV-2); COVID-19.

If you encounter a decedent that exhibited signs and symptoms indicative of a COVID-19 infection, the Health Officer may want to arrange for testing. Collect as much health history as possible and contact the health district at 509-539-0416 to discuss specimen collection. The decision to test will be determined on a case by case basis.
