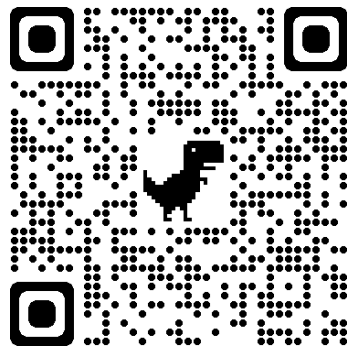

## POP UP COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC CBC-West/Argent Rd. APRIL 11, 2021 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Benton-Franklin Health District is pleased to offer a Pop-up Vaccine Clinic on Sunday, April 11, from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the CBC-West location at 3110 W. Argent Rd., Pasco, WA 99301. This clinic is open for all who are eligible including our community food processing and agricultural workers. 200 appointments are available through the PrepMod reservation system.

The clinic is intended to provide a safe and convenient location for community members to receive the one dose **Johnson & Johnson** COVID-19 vaccine.

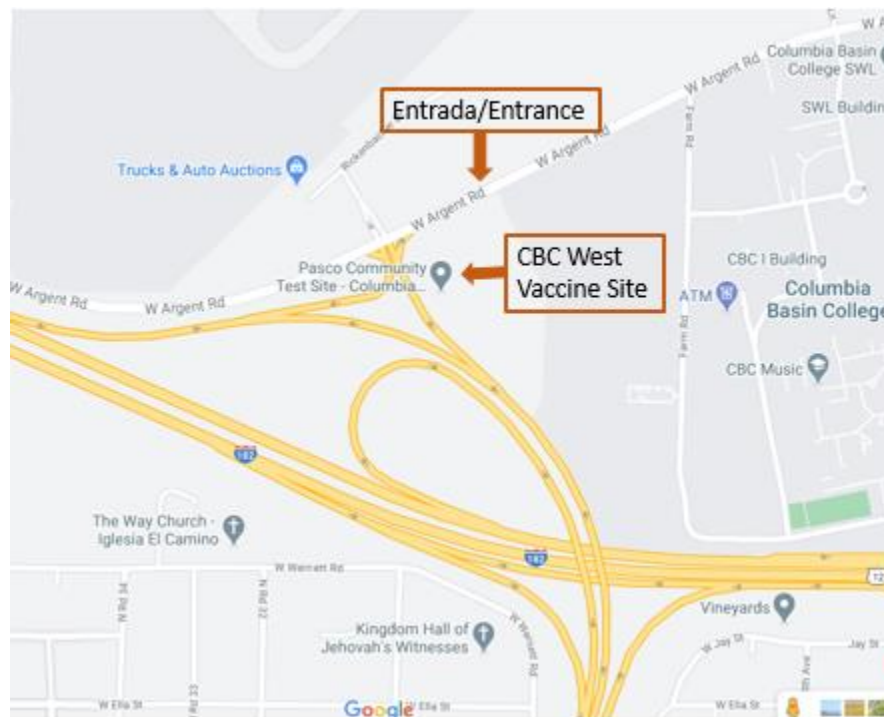

- Follow the signs to the CBC-West Testing Site - the vaccine clinic is located at the same site
