Benton-Franklin Health District is pleased to offer a free Pop-up Vaccine Clinic in coordination with Columbia Safety on Sunday, April 25, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the CBC-West location at 3110 W. Argent Rd., Pasco. This clinic is open for all age 18+.

400 Moderna vaccinations will be given. Reservations are required.

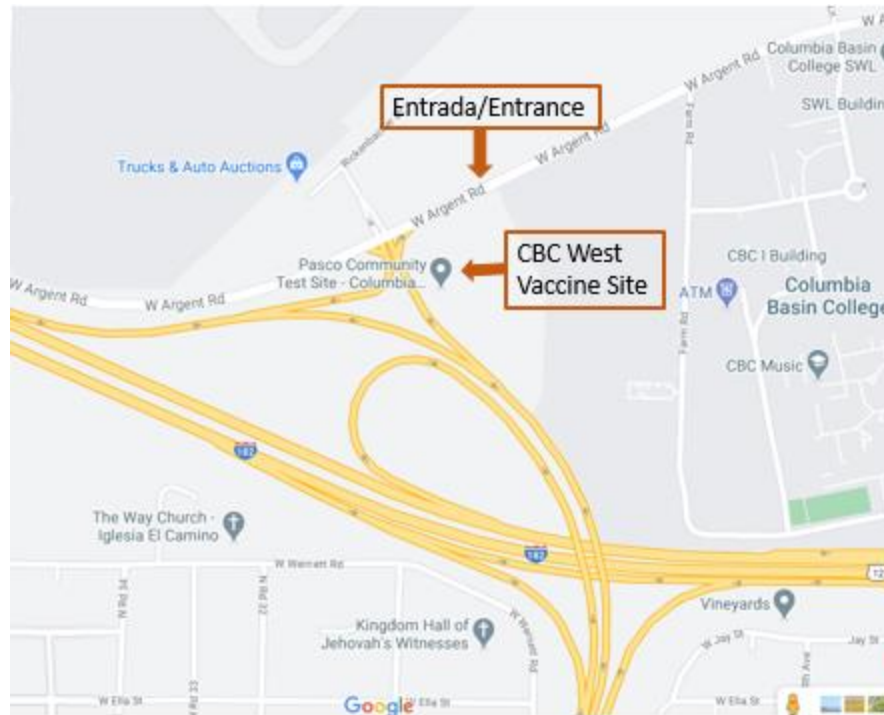
- Registration for the 400 appointment times is first come/first serve

- No proof of residency or immigration status will be requested
- Vans with less than 15 pre-registered people are welcome for transporting to the clinic site
- Expected wait time after receiving the vaccination is 15 minutes
- Do not arrive for your appointment earlier than your scheduled time due to space restrictions
- Follow the signs to the CBC-West COVID-19 Testing Site - the vaccine clinic is located at the same site
