FREE COVID-19 “DRIVE-THRU” VACCINE CLINIC
CBC-West/Argent Rd.
Sunday, May 2, 2021 - 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The Benton-Franklin Health District, in coordination with Columbia Safety LLC, holds FREE Drive-Thru Vaccine Clinic at the CBC-West COVID test site on Sundays

This week’s event is occurring Sunday, May 2 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at 3110 W. Argent Rd., Pasco. The clinic is open for all age 18+ with a focus on those living and working in our counties who are having difficulty accessing vaccination during the week.

200 Moderna vaccinations will be given. Reservations are required. The Health District wants to continue to remind the public that vaccinations are safe and effective and are the key to combatting viral spread in our community. There is no live virus in the vaccine and like all vaccines, no effect on fertility. Some, but not all, people experience mild to moderate symptoms after vaccination including a sore arm, a low fever, chills, muscle ache and/or nausea – lasting about 24 hours.

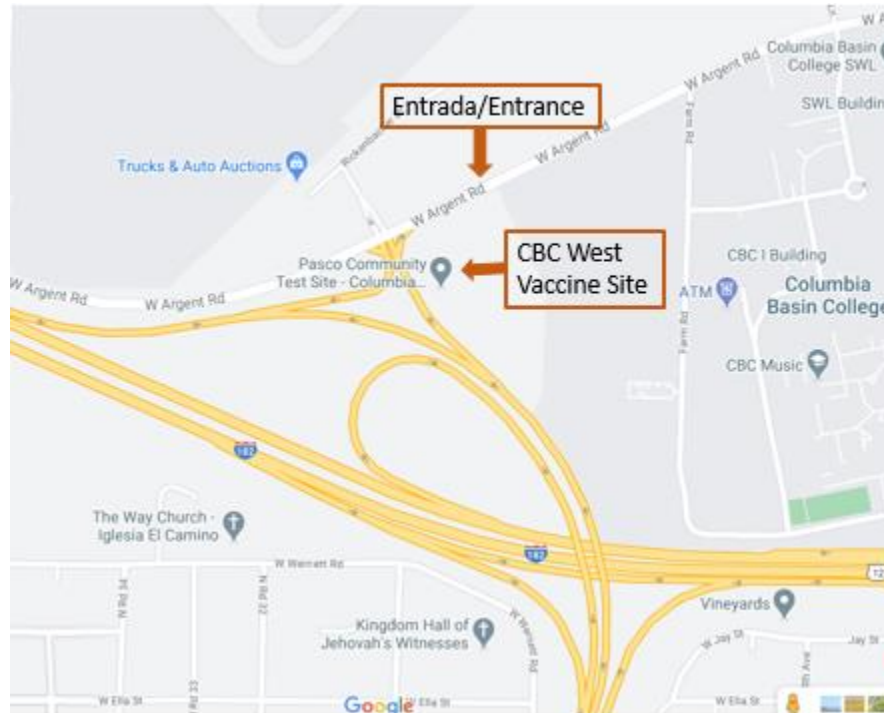
